# PLAYING RULE MODIFICATION FOR ZONE 8

### LOCAL LEAGUE DEVELOPMENT

## <u>2025</u>

#### **Game Format**

• All games consist of three (3) twelve (12) minute periods.

#### **Cross-Checking and Body-Checking**

- NOT permitted in any division.
- Players may use the portion of the stick held between the hands to **touch and control** the ball carrier.

#### **U9 Division Specifics**

- Game Format
  - Games will be 3 on 3 and will be played on half floor
- Shift Changes:
  - A shift buzzer will sound every two (2) minutes.
  - The clock will stop during the shift change.
  - Players must exchange quickly to minimize "Dead Ball" time.

#### • Restarting Play:

- Possession is awarded to the team that last had possession or was closest to a loose ball.
- Infractions:
  - Play will stop, and the infraction will be explained to the offending player.
  - The player will be sent to their bench.
  - The team with the infraction will play down one (1) player until the next buzzer.

#### • After a Goal:

- Play resumes with possession in the crease of the team that was scored upon.
- The scoring team must retreat and "Tag up" outside their attacking zone before pressuring the ball.

- Passing Rules:
  - Players must make at least one (1) pass before attempting to score.
  - Clarification: A pass requires the ball to leave one player's stick and travel through the air or along the ground to another player. Dropping the ball into a teammate's stick (a "handoff") is NOT considered a pass.

### U11 and Up Division Specifics

- Game Format
  - o Games will be 4 on 4 full floor
- Passing Rules:
  - Players must make at least two (2) passes before attempting to score.
  - At least one (1) pass must occur in the offensive zone.
  - Clarification: A pass requires the ball to leave one player's stick and travel through the air or along the ground to another player. Dropping the ball into a teammate's stick (a "handoff") is NOT considered a pass.

### Scoring and awarding Goals

### \*\*NEW IN 2025\*\*

- Face Offs
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Face offs will be done at the start of each period and after goals.
  - If a team has 5 (or greater) goal lead, the losing team will be awarded possession after they are scored on.
  - If the team losing by 5 or more goals scores, a face off will take place.
- Penalties
  - Players will now serve their penalties in the penalty box, in compliance with the OLA interpretation of the CLA Rule and Situation Handbook.
